“A MAN OF CONSISTENCY”

“It’s not easy lovin’ a woman, Sam.” Jimmy Stewart

Your “I do” will always mean “Do you?” to her.

- She acts hurt when you spend time alone
- She doesn’t believe you have a “nothing” box
- She needs to always want to talk about your relationship
- She seems to doubt your trustworthiness about your vow

****These are warning lights signaling a breach in your wife’s confidence about your love.**

“You know that record that’s always running in a guy’s head about providing? Well, we have the same fundamental concern about our relationship all the time.” (one woman’s perspective)

The biblical prototype: the WATCHMAN

- He stands on the watchtower
- Sees the big picture
- Watches for danger
- Stays alert and warns of trouble
- Announces when all is well

How can I be a watchman for my wife?

- ◆ Never assume
- ◆ Constantly stand guard
- ◆ Recognize the signs of danger
- ◆ Never tire of reassuring her of your love and commitment.
- ◆ Pursue her! Get 1-ahead. Stay proactive
